WARM CAULIFLOWER SPREAD

from the kitchen of Lea Darling (served at the 2015 Oktoberfest)

- 4 cups florets, no bigger than 1 ½ inches long
- 2 Tbsp olive oil, plus more for drizzling
- 1/2 tsp kosher salt
- 4 oz softened goat cheese
- $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp freshly crushed pink peppercorns, divided. (I used black because that is what I had.)
- 1 Tbsp chopped chives
- 1 Tbsp chopped parsley

Preheat oven to 450°F. Toss cauliflower in large bowl with 2 Tbsp olive oil and salt. Arrange in a single layer on rimmed baking sheet: bake 10 minutes. Toss with a spatula, rotate baking sheet: bake 10 minutes more until deeply golden brown and tender.

Remove from oven, cool slightly. Transfer to a food processor bowl. Add goat cheese and 1/4 tsp of peppercorns: pulse until smooth. Stir in chives and parsley. Transfer to serving dish, drizzle with oil and remaining peppercorns.

Serve with chips for dipping (I used pita chips.) Enjoy!

Many of our POCs have been administering certain walks for years and would like to "retire." New POCs are needed for Saratoga National Historical Park (the Battlefield) and Clifton Park.

The two main tasks of the Vice President are to fill in for the President when needed and to plan, formally sanction and work with the POCs of the seven or eight Traditional Events each year. Three of these walks (Oktoberfest, Pizza Party and Holiday Party), take place at previous locations and are therefore "established." The vice president is normally, but not necessarily, a member of standing committees. It is desired, but not required, that the Vice President become the succeeding President. We need YOU!


