Our treasurer, Warren Lavery, has announced at a recent meeting that ESCV spent over \$600 more than it took in last year. Many of us remember a huge surplus in excess of \$10,000 in the treasury which we have worked on spending down. But it turns out for the past ten years we have spent more than we have earned. With a current surplus of \$4000, we will be operating in the red in about seven years if we continue our current spending habits. This raises the question of whether we should be looking at ways of raising revenue or cutting back. Come to the meeting to share ideas.



ESCV Holiday Party


