Using the Online Start Box (OLSB) by Monica Hait

Do you want to do our Cheshire Appalachian Trail hike or others in the Appalachian Trail Program? Have you noticed all the Mississippi What about that trip you're planning to Yosemite, will there be volkswalks?

For events like the ones mentioned above, a little pre-planning is the key to being able to enjoy those AVA sanctioned events. With remote start points, ones without a physical building to host the usual start box, clubs are increasingly deciding to use the Online Start Box (OLSB) system originated by the California Volkssport Association (CVA). Another reason a club may decide to go online is that no club member is local enough to ensure the box is stocked regularly and maintained appropriately (this has happened with multiple seasonals in Vermont).

So how does a volkswalker get started with online events? This is where the pre-planning comes in. First, you need to create a login within the CVA online system (www.cva4u.org & click the left side link of Online Start Box). They say it should take about 10 minutes to get the account set up. Note: each person needs to have a separate login email address (sorry, no joint accounts). Next, vou'll need to electronically acknowledge ("sign") the athletic waiver. Then you need to associate a PayPal account with your OLSB account to facilitate payments for any events you choose to participate in.

Once those pieces are accomplished, you are ready to register for any of the many events available in OLSB.

Mike Green, formerly of New York and now the Atlantic Regional Director, created a series of videos to aid understanding on how to use the OLSB. Watch them on his site: www.nodegreen.com/olsb

Note: this online system does not allow Free participants, a minimal charge is incurred for walk directions even if not walking for credit. Register using the Online Start Box provided by the California Volkssport Association (www.cva4u.org).

• From the CVA site, click the left side link for Online Start Box (OLSB), follow the instructions to sign waiver & register for an event.

- Payments for event credit and/or walk directions use PayPal.
- All event related directions and insert cards are PDFs that you can download and print as needed (for event, distance, & special program books).
- The POC does not provide event directions or accept alternate payment methods when an event uses OLSB.
- The entire online process should take less than 10 minutes for a first time user.
- Driving directions, parking details, and specific start point location received AFTER completing Online Start Box event registration and payment. Walk instructions & route map also included in the packet.
- If you frequently walk with someone, it is possible to link your OLSB accounts (and/or use the same PayPal) for easier registration management.
- Once you've completed an event, be sure to log back into the OLSB to officially finish and receive event credit & insert card PDF.
- While the OLSB originated in the CVA system, it will be moved to the AVA site in the next year. Existing CVA OLSB logins will transfer over to the AVA system when that happens
