Our Thursday musical evening provided a real sense of place listening to the folk music from the area. Workshops with topics related to the walks (Erie Canal, Saratoga Battlefield, Albany Architecture, Underground Railroad, Cooperstown) were other avenues for introducing our visitors to the history and significance of the area. How fitting that the table decorations at the Friday night banquet were dutch shoes and American flags.

WE hope you were able to get your picture with Sal the Mule visiting from the Erie Canal in front of the hotel welcoming convention goers or at the American Legion in Schuylerville, or at the President's Walk in Albany or at the Desserts and Music dancing and rocking out when we all sang 400 Miles on the Erie Canal, or...Post your photos on America's Walking Club for all to enjoy. Our 2019 Convention Picture Frame was seen all over the hotel and at some of the walks getting plenty of shutter time as folks picked it up and took photos of themselves and with new friends.

Who remembers when the only walk available on a Wednesday was a 10k walk at 6pm? If you do recall those days, you were a working and much younger person than you are now.

Once our members started retiring, a group lobbied for a morning walk but it was still a 10k route. As happens when time goes by, needs change and so do structures. Some members began needing shorter walk distances and the 5k option was born. It was only in the past four years that a relaxed 5k was added to the mix. But this year it was noted that the regular 5k was getting more and more stretched out, as was the 10k I might add, and the relaxed group was growing and growing.

To accommodate the continuing changing needs of our members, a discussion took place at the May meeting as to how best meet the new needs. It was decided that a 20 minute mile walker in the 10k group could identify themselves and lead that group. A second somewhat slower 10k group would follow. But this would only happen if a leader were available to take on the first group.

The 5kers required a more definitive arrangement. It was decided to adopt the AVA motto of Fun, Fitness and Friendship to denote the groups. The • Fitness walkers • would walk a 20 minute mile. The • Fun walkers • would walk at a slightly slower pace. The • Friendship crowd • would do a shorter walk at a much slower pace.

What this means is that we need identified leaders and sweeps who will be reliably available to make sure the groups are accommodated. Please think about volunteering to be a leader or a sweep at least once each season. It makes the POC's job much easier if you volunteer before the day of the walk. Volunteer for a group that you don't usually join and get to know other members of the club. A bonus is the privilege of wearing a yellow vest and cars will stop for you.



ESCV AS HOST OF THE 2019 AVA CONVENTION

Save the Date SEPTEMBER 14, 2019 NORTHVILLE Our first traditional event of the autumn

Come and walk in Northville, a historic village located on the shores of Great Sacandaga Lake in the foothills of the Adirondacks. The village was first settled in 1786 but became a more flourishing community during the 19th center when the FJ&G Railroad brought visitors to the newly created Sacandaga Park resort where hundreds of summer cottages and large hotels were built from 1875.



The region changed greatly when the Valley was flooded to create the Sacandaga Lake Reservoir to control the flood waters of the Hudson River. Today much of the Northville's historic residential architecture remains and the Main Street was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 2014. It is said that the Northville Five and Dime is the oldest operating 5 and 10 cent store in America.



Five years ago this month Lea Darling suggested ESCV host the National Convention since the convention had never been held in the Northeast. Our bid to do so was accepted on the second try thus ushering in two years of intense planning. It is due to Lea's vision, energy and devotion that ESCV did indeed host in 2019 and by all accounts it was a job well done.

- Socials Attendance Numbers: Meet & Greet (Take Me Out to the Ballgame)-377, Desserts & Traditional Music-343, Banquet-364


