Online Start Box

Have you ever traveled to a city looking for the walk box and the location was closed? And if open, no one knew where the box was? Or finding it, the directions were gone?! Even if all goes well, you're left to stamp your books, remember to bring home the envelope, address, stamp and post it with a check inside. And once that is done, mail your books to AVA HQ, hoping they don't get lost.

The Online Start Box was built to eliminate the above problems. The system was designed by Chris Zegelin, a member of an AVA club in California. After years of successful operation there, it was adopted by AVA national. Walks can be found, maps and directions printed, and credits received online 24/7/365. Alas, nothing is free. There is a small processing fee added to the cost of each walk - further details below.

Many clubs throughout the country already use the OSB system, which will become more prevalent over time. Close to home, the Twin States Club has a few OSB events, the Appalachian Trail hikes are mostly OSB, as well as many events in the Niagara Frontier. Seven of our members just used OSB for a New York City walk.

ESCV will get on board with five OSB events in 2020

We are starting with Lake Placid and Cooperstown, mainly due to their remote locations. No longer will POCs need to travel there to monitor and stock walk boxes. Tad Darling has created two OSB bicycling events at the Saratoga Battlefield and Schenectady. And we have a new Albany Pine Bush Preserve event sanctioned for the last quarter of this year, plus all of 2020, for walking, hiking or snowshoeing.

Save the date... this October 16 for a Group Event at the Albany Pine Bush Preserve. This will be a test run for those who want to try out our club's first OSB at our newest location! But if you're not an OSBer, don't worry you can sign up with traditional registration sheets, and get stamped, just as you've always done. We have designed routes for everyone, from a fun and interesting casual walk in and around the Discovery Center, to more strenuous hikes where boots and poles should be considered. The preserve opens at 9 a.m., when Kathy and Wayne will be there to assist anyone with OSB or traditional registration. Group walks/hikes begin at 10 a.m.

For those who would like to become familiar with the Online Start Box, it's quite simple and you can do it from your home computer or a smartphone. Any questions? one of your experienced OSB friends will be glad to help you, and you can call Kathy or Wayne at any time. Or better yet, catch them at the next walk or meeting.

OSB Registration Steps

- Get into the https://my.ava.org website.
- Tap the New Account tab.
- Enter the requested information such as your name, email address and password (write down your password and keep it with you).

OSB Walk Directions and Maps

- Get into the https://my.ava.org website.
- Tap on the Login tab.
- Tap the Login button.
- Tap the My Event Bank tab.
- Enter the amount you want to deposit in your event bank, from \$3 (the cost for one walk) to a maximum of \$100. Note there is a sliding scale per walk processing fee ranging from 49 cents for one \$3 walk, down to 10 cents per walk if the maximum \$100 is banked.
- Use your credit or debit card to deposit funds in your event bank. The funds do not have an expiration date.
- Tap on My Start Box.
- Scroll down to New York, Albany Pine Bush Preserve.
- Tap on Register.
- Get maps and directions.

After OSB Walk

Get back into the https://my.ava.org website. Tap on Login.

Tap on Finish Table to get credits and stamps.
